Welcome to the Y Rowing Centre

The following information might help to familiarise you with your new club.

- As a member you have access the clubrooms and facilities 24-hours a day, 7 days a week – except when the Lake is closed to the public for the Grand Prix for example.
- **All rowing fees include Sports Injury Insurance, Loss of Income and Physio.**
- As a new member you can attend ASquad on Sundays at 9am or Wednesdays at 6pm. This is where you will meet other members and find a crew.
- The club has an harassment-free policy in place, a copy of which is on display on the noticeboard between the clubrooms and the boatshed.
- You will be able to row in boats suitable to your level of experience. Boats are allocated on the booking board near the roller door. Please ensure that when you take a boat out on the water you log it out in the book provided. All boats need to be washed before being returned to the rack.
- Coaching and coaching clinics are available to Members.
- Lockers available for hire, please see Club Secretary.

RESPONSIBILITIES

You will be expected to:

- act in the best interests of Y Rowing and to ensure that your actions do not damage the facilities or equipment;
- attend club functions including the annual tidy-up and boat maintenance days;
- report damage to boats or equipment o the board provided situated between the clubrooms and the boat shed;
- attend the Annual General Meeting in July;
- participate in the Y Annual Regatta held at Albert Park Lake;
- assist at a beginners session once or twice a year. You will receive notice from the Beginners Co-ordinator prior to the date, and if unable to attend you are expected to advise the co-ordinator or find a replacement. There are various aspects to the sessions and one will be found to suit your level of rowing experience. These once-a-month beginners sessions are important for sustaining our membership.

SUSPENSION OR CANCELLATION OF YOUR MEMBERSHIP is permitted two months after payment with one month's notice in writing. Members using Ezypay may apply after a minimum of 2 months but suspension of payments will be effective only after 6 monthly payments have been deducted. A cancellation fee (the \$50 non-refundable joining fee) will apply. Minimum period for temporary membership suspension shall be 3 months. Maximum period of temporary membership suspension shall be 12 months. Please request a Membership Suspension and Cancellation Form.
